Subject: REQUEST FROM VEORIDE TO LEASE ONE PARKING SPACE FOR FREE ON GARDEN STREET FROM APRIL 1, 2019 TO DECEMBER 31, 2019.

VeoRide, a mobility share company, has been operating a dockless bike share program in Nashua since June 2018. They have requested that one parking space on Garden Street behind the Elm Street Parking Garage be designated for bike parking. This is a low-cost approach several bike share companies are using to deal with bike parking issues in public spaces and to provide a level of comfort to users who like the idea of the program but are anxious about being able to consistently find a bike. This location is ideal as it is in close proximity to the Transit Center, the Rail Trail, and Main Street, where data shows bikes are frequently ridden.

The City is sending this request to the Infrastructure Committee via NRO 320-47, E which states "Upon authorization by the Infrastructure Committee, the City may lease parking lots or spaces to non-City entities at a rate approved by the Infrastructure Committee."

This request is supported by the Parking Department.
