SUBJ.: Response to questions on overnight bans with fines

Alderman Caron,

Here are the answers to your questions.

1)What are the overnight times?

In non-permit areas, there is no overnight parking allowed between the hours of midnight and 6AM for more than 2 hours. In permit areas, there is no overnight parking allowed between midnight and 6AM without a permit.

2)Are they out 5 nights? 7 nights?

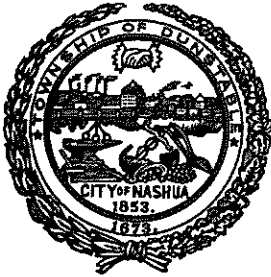
These rules are in place 7 nights per week.

3)What are other towns doing and have implemented?

I have included a spreadsheet of some of the other towns that have overnight parking bans.

Overnight Parking - Other Municipalities

	Municipality	Overnight Parking Ban Description	Amount	Late Fee
	Manchester, NH	Odd/Even Rule (Parked on Wrong Side of Street)	\$25	After 30 days - Amount increases to \$50 & After 60 days Amount increases to \$60
	Durham, NH	No Overnight Parking downtown lots and street (again similar to Nashua)	\$25	After 14 days - Amount increases to \$30
	Newton, MA	No overnight parking on-street parking Dec. 1 - March 31 for longer than 1 hour between the hours of 2AM and 6AM	\$25	After 90 Days - Amount increases to \$75
	Brookline, MA	No overnight parking on-street year-round for longer than 1 hour between the hours of 2AM and 6AM	\$30	After 21 Days - Amount increases to \$40
	Portland, ME	2 night per mo restriction 10/1 - 5/31	\$40+\$35 Impound Fee + \$100 Tow Fee/\$35	



ORDINANCE

REDUCING THE FINE FOR OVERNIGHT PARKING VIOLATIONS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIII “Night Parking” Section 320-78 “Parking time limits”, subsection B of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“320-78 Parking time limits.

...

- B. Anyone violating this provision shall be fined a minimum of ~~\$25~~10. If such fine is not paid within seven days, the fine shall increase by \$10, to ~~\$35~~20.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded only to the extent necessary to effectuate this legislation.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE: A sixty percent reduction in the overnight parking violation fine amount would result in an approximate loss in annual enforcement revenue of \$225,000 to \$250,000.
