



ORDINANCE

PERMITTING AMPLIFIED SOUND IN GREELEY PARK WITH A DECIBEL LEVEL LIMITATION

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 215 “Parks and Recreation Areas”, Article I “Park and Playground Rules”, Section 215-2.1 “Greeley Park”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and is hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 215-2.1. Greeley Park.

~~Except for Summer Fun events and programs, and any groups or individuals who have applied for future use of the park prior to March 23, 2010, use of Greeley Park shall be limited to non-amplified use.~~ Use of Greeley Park for amplified sound is permitted as long as the sound does not exceed 65 decibels as measured at the back side of the Swart Terrace property line.”

This ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
