



## ORDINANCE

### PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR SALE, LEASE OR RENT ON PUBLIC STREETS OR IN CITY-OWNED PUBLIC PARKING LOTS

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the new underlined section as follows:

**“§ 320-77.1. Parking of motor vehicles for sale, lease or rent on public streets or in city-owned public parking lots.”**

**It shall be unlawful for any vehicle sales, lease or rental business to cause or permit a vehicle to be parked on a public street or in a city-owned public parking lot while such vehicle is in the custody, control, or possession of the business for the purpose of being parked or offered for sale, lease or rent. For the purposes of this section, “vehicle sales, lease or rental business” means the business of offering any new or used vehicle for sale, lease, or rent.”**

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage.

**ANALYSIS**

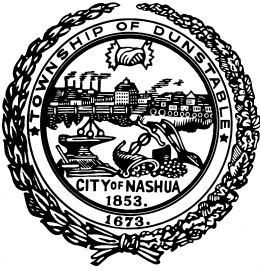
This ordinance prohibits businesses that sell, lease or rent, new or used vehicles from parking vehicles under their control or custody on public streets or in public parking lots.

## ORDINANCE

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the new underlined section as follows:

**“§ 320-77.1. Parking of motor vehicles for sale, lease or rent on public streets or in city-owned public parking lots by any vehicle sales, lease or rental business.”**

It shall be unlawful for any vehicle sales, lease or rental business to cause or permit a vehicle to be parked on a public street or in a city-owned public parking lot while such vehicle is in the custody, control, or possession of the business for the purpose of being parked or offered for sale, lease or rent. For the purposes of this section, “vehicle sales, lease or rental business” means the business of offering any new or used vehicle for sale, lease, or rent. The fine for a violation of this provision shall be \$50 and \$75 for a seven (7) day delay.”

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage.
