



## ORDINANCE

### ESTABLISHING NASHVILLE STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION AND PERMITTING PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STREET

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Article VII “One-Way Streets”, Section 320-27 “One-way streets at all times”, add the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

**“§ 320-27. One-way streets at all times.**

The following streets are hereby designated as one-way streets:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Direction of travel</b>	<b>Location</b>
...		
<u>Nashville Street</u>	<u>Westerly</u>	<u>Entire length</u> ”

2. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, delete the struck-through language as shown:

**“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

3. In Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-4 “Stop intersections”, subsection D, delete the struck-through language as shown:

**“§ 320-4. Stop intersections.**

...

D. The following intersections are hereby designated as stop or through streets, and authority is hereby granted for the erection of a stop sign at the corner so designated in accordance with the tenor of this chapter:

<b>Stop Sign on</b>	<b>Sign Location</b>	<b>At Intersection of</b>

<del>Nashville Street</del>	<del>Southwest corner</del>	<del>Concord Street”</del>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).

**ANALYSIS**

This legislation would establish Nashville Street as a one-way street traveling west between Concord Street and Amherst Street. As a result of the street becoming one way, the legislation also allows parking on the north side of the street and removes a no longer needed stop sign at Nashville's intersection with Concord Street.

Authority for this ordinance is found in NH RSA 47:17 VIII (a), which states that city councils may make ordinances regarding the use of vehicles on particular highways and to exclude vehicles altogether from certain ways. The erection, removal, and maintenance of traffic devices and signals shall conform to applicable state statutes and the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. NH RSA 47:17 VIII (a). The Board should consult with the Engineering Department to determine if this ordinance is in compliance.
