



ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PARKING OR STOPPING AT ANY TIME ON A PORTION OF WEST HOLLIS STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen

The City of Nashua ordains that the following sections of Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-68 “No parking or stopping on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, Subsection A as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§320-68. No parking or stopping on certain streets.

A. No parking or stopping of any vehicle shall be permitted on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location

<u>West Hollis Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From Edwards Street 110 feet in the westerly direction”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary sign(s).

ANALYSIS

This legislation prohibits parking or stopping at any time on a portion of the north side of West Hollis Street (near Dunkin Donuts).

The erection, removal and maintenance of all traffic control devices must conform to applicable state statutes and the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. RSA 47:17 VIII (a). The Board should consult with the City Traffic Engineer to determine if this ordinance is in compliance.
