RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua and the Community Development Division are authorized to accept and appropriate a New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services Brownfields Cleanup Revolving Loan Fund Petroleum Subgrant of \$200,000. The grant will be appropriated into Special Revenue Account #371-7035 and will be used toward the cleanup and remediation of environmental contamination at the former Nashua Manufacturing Company Boiler House and Coal Storage Building property. The local match of \$40,000 (20% of the total project cost) will be provided from approved CDBG funds. This resolution also authorizes the transfer of the local match to Special Revenue Account #371-7035.


The fiscal impact is a \$200,000 grant to the City to be used for a specific purpose. There is a \$40,000 cash match required which is approved from CDBG funds.

ANALYSIS


