

RESOLUTION

HONORING BRAD HILL AND GOODALE'S BIKE SHOP

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that

WHEREAS, Goodale's Bike Shop was first established by Walt Goodale in 1919, and was later run by his son, Roscoe Goodale. Goodale's Bike Shop has been located in and around Railroad Square in Nashua, New Hampshire since it was founded.

WHEREAS, in 1966 a young Brad Hill was offered a part-time job by Roscoe Goodale to work in the bike shop. Five years later, when Mr. Goodale was ready to retire, Brad Hill convinced his parents that the shop would be a good investment. In June of 1971 Brad Hill became the owner of Goodale's Bicycle Shop.

WHEREAS, the business continued to grow, and in 1978 Brad Hill moved Goodale's Bike Shop into 46 Main Street, currently the Peddler's Daughter. Here it remained a staple of the Nashua downtown for many years. While at this location, the business grew to completely occupy what was once a multi-tenant building. Finally in July of 2002, Brad Hill found a facility that would handle his entire operation of sales, service, warehousing, and administration at 14B Broad Street in Nashua.

WHEREAS, Goodale's Bike Shop continues to lead the way in providing greater selection and service. In 1997 Brad Hill opened a shop in Hooksett, NH and in 2005 he opened a shop in Concord, NH providing both expertise and opportunities to those seeking recreational as well as competitive cycling.

WHEREAS, Goodale's Bike Shop continues to grow and is one of the largest bike shops in the country.

WHEREAS, Whereas Brad Hill's dedication to the City of Nashua also extends to having served as a member of the Nashua Chamber of Commerce; President of the Heart of Nashua; member of the Downtown Development Corporation; and current member of the Nashua Police Crime Line.

NOW THEREFORE, Mayor Donnalee Lozeau and the Board of Aldermen, on behalf of the citizens of Nashua, express their thanks and appreciation to Brad Hill and his staff for 45 years of service to both the citizens of Nashua and the State of New Hampshire.
