WHEREAS, the Ethnic Awareness Committee was established "to facilitate communication between the ethnic community and city government" and to encourage understanding and appreciation of ethnic diversity in our City.

WHEREAS, the Ethnic Awareness Committee recognized that the City, its ethnic communities, city government, and community organizations would benefit from a program designed to educate youth among the city's many diverse populations regarding the roles of city government and community organizations and organize those youths so they can prepare to be future community leaders.
