UPDATING THE CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN FOR HUD PROGRAMS TO REFLECT ASSESSMENT OF FAIR HOUSING REQUIREMENTS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seventeen

WHEREAS the City is required to have an adopted Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) that sets forth the City's policies and procedures for citizen participation related to the Consolidated Plan, including public hearing requirements, how the City will reach out to underserved populations, accepting public comment and other key participation requirements;

WHEREAS the City most recently adopted its Citizen Participation Plan on June 8, 2010, through R-10-25, amended;

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) revised the CPP regulations to include new community participation requirements for developing an Assessment of Fair Housing (formerly the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing); and

WHEREAS the City revised its CPP to meet the new requirements, published a draft of the Plan, and allowed at least a 14-day comment period.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City hereby adopts by reference this newly revised Citizen Participation Plan. This Plan is on file for inspection at the Community Development Division, City Hall, 229 Main Street; and on the City's website (www.nashuanh.gov) under the Urban Programs Department.
