



ORDINANCE

ADDING TWO STUDENT MEMBERS TO THE ENVIRONMENT AND ENERGY COMMITTEE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Nineteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 12 “Boards, Committees and Commissions”, Article V “Environment and Energy Committee”, Section 12-15 “Membership”, subsections B and C of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 12-15. Membership

...

- B. The Committee shall also consist of the following members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Board of Aldermen:
- (1) Three representatives from the private business sector, each with a personal interest or expertise in environmental or energy issues; ~~and~~
 - (2) Three community members, each with an interest or expertise in environmental or energy issues; ~~and~~ and
 - (3) Two high school students, each with an interest or expertise in environmental or energy issues.
- C. Members of the Committee appointed and confirmed under Subsection B(1) and B(2) will serve for three-year terms. Members of the Committee appointed and confirmed under Subsection B(3) will serve for one calendar-year terms.”

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
