This funding is effective from March 4, 2020 through June 30, 2020.

FISCAL NOTE:

Fiscal impact is an up to \$830,000 grant to be used for a specific purpose. The stipend is not considered earnable compensation for the purposes of employer retirement contributions however the City is responsible for funding Federal employment taxes estimated to be approximately \$12,035.

ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the City of Nashua to accept and appropriate up to \$830,000 from the State of New Hampshire, Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES ACT") Fund for the purpose of providing a \$300 weekly stipend to first responders for 8 weeks. This funding is effective from March 4, 2020 through June 30, 2020.
