RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua and Nashua Fire Rescue are authorized to accept \$128,781.82 from the Department of Homeland Security into Fire Grant Activity "FY2020 Assistance to Firefighters Grant" for the purpose of providing periodic physical exams and health screening for 180 fire members. This resolution also authorizes the transfer of matching funds in the amount of \$12,878.18 from Department #152 "Fire Department", Account #53135 "Medical Services".

ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the City to accept funds from the Federal Department of Homeland Security for the purpose described in the resolution and authorizes the transfer of matching funds from the Fire Department's FY2022 General Fund operating budget.

Charter Sec. 53 permits the Board of Aldermen to transfer any unencumbered appropriation balance or any portion from one department, fund or agency to another.

NRO 5-130, H provides that "when proposed legislation to transfer or re-appropriate a particular appropriation or purpose thereof has had its first reading, such funds shall not be expended or transferred while the legislation is pending".
