Bill Text: PROHIBITING URINATING AND DEFECATING IN PUBLIC

In the Year Two Thousand and Three The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 14 "Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions", Article I "In General", of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new section as follows: "Sec. 14-1. Urinating and Defecating in Public. (a) It is hereby determined that urinating and defecating in public places other than in public facilities intended for those purposes are detrimental to the public health, welfare and safety, erode the integrity of the environment, annoy or disturb reasonable people of normal sensibilities, disrupt the quality of life, and are contrary to the public interest of the citizens of Nashua. (b) No person shall urinate or defecate in a public place other than in public facilities intended for those purposes." All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
