

QUICK FACTS

Childhood Blood Lead Testing

- NH SB 247 Universal Testing Law states you must perform a blood lead level (BLL) test for all 1 and 2 year olds.
- If a child has an elevated BLL result (EBLL) you must order a second venous test to confirm OR sign a declaration of EBLL so the child may enter case management.
- Children 3 to 6 years old who have not previously been tested or are at elevated risk should also be tested.
- All insurance companies are required to cover the costs of these tests. If a patient is uninsured, contact us to locate a testing location.
