

Weather hazard plan: (Location)

Posting and educating all employees of the weather hazard safety plan.

A designated point person (Name), (Name) or (Name) in that order of present on site will be responsible for checking the forecast via the National Weather Station and Local WMUR weather alerts and deciding if the weather is suitable for service that day.

This point person will also be in charge of the emergency plan and will be on site for the entire shift. The point person will be responsible during their shift for monitoring the weather and determining whether to evacuate. If an evacuation is necessary they will act decisively and authoritatively to instruct the guests to do so.

Daily inspection of the canopy, to include water pooling, strap weakness or other wear and tear.

We will only be serving customers during fair & mild weather conditions. Expected wind conditions in excess of 20 Miles or Lighting storms will force closure until conditions are improved.

Staff will be sure that guests are aware of any inclement weather that is in the forecast via Voice or portable PA announcements

The canopy/tents only purpose if for sun shade and light rain. All other weather conditions shall be considered hazardous and an evacuation plan will be in place for any unforeseen immediate severe weather conditions.

THE CANOPY/TENT IS NOT DESIGNED FOR USE AS SHELTER IN SEVERE WEATHER.

In the event of unexpected severe weather the evacuation plan will be implemented.

The point person will announce by voice or over the PA for guests to follow all employees directions to return to their vehicles in a calm and safe manor. They will be instructed to remain there until an announcement is made that it is safe to return to their tables.
